Goal

Fleet Challenge Ontario, with our award supporters, wishes to recognize and reward individuals for their green fleet leadership. To this end, each year we will present a number of Green Fleet Leadership Awards to individuals for their accomplishments in the previous 1 year period.

The annual Fleet Challenge Ontario (FCO) Green Fleet Leadership Awards will be presented in conjunction with the annual Green Fleet Expo as presented by the cities of Hamilton and Toronto with Fleet Challenge Ontario.

Objectives

The annual Fleet Challenge Ontario Green Fleet Leadership Awards will be presented in recognition of accomplishments made by Ontario's private and public sector fleet managers in making their on-road, licensed motor vehicle fleets more environmentally responsible and/or having reduced fuel consumption, harmful greenhouse gas emissions and smog causing air contaminants in the previous one-year period.

The Awards

Awards will be made in recognition of individual performance by nominees and will be presented in these categories:

- 1) Green Fleet Leadership Award - Lifetime Achievement
- 2) Green Fleet Leadership Award - Private Sector
- 3) Green Fleet Leadership Award - Public Sector

Eligibility

- Nominees must be employed by, or have some degree of responsibility for, an Ontario based fleets or fleets with operations within Ontario.
- Nominee's fleet must have a good, satisfactory (or better) CVOR record.

Nomination

- Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another.
- Nominees, or those who nominate someone, must submit a Fleet Challenge Ontario Green Fleet Leadership Award Nomination form.

- Nominations will be accepted until April 30 each year.

Winning an FCO Green Fleet Award

- Awards, other than those for Lifetime Achievement, will be based on green fleet accomplishments by nominees during the preceding 1 year.
- Nominations will be reviewed and scored by a 5 person Peer Review Panel as selected by Fleet Challenge Ontario.
- Nominations will be scored using a point-based system, with those receiving the most points in their Award category being declared the winner(s).
- Points will be awarded for accomplishments or improvements based on the 10 E3 tenets of:
 1. Green fleet Action Plan
 2. Training & Awareness
 3. Idling Reduction
 4. Vehicle Specs
 5. Fuel Data Management
 6. Operations & Maintenance
 7. Trip & Route Planning
 8. Utilization Management
 9. Fuel Efficiency Improvement
 10. Greenhouse Gas Reduction
- Additional points may also be awarded by the Peer Review Panel for innovation as described by the nominee on the nomination form.
- The Peer Review Panel may, at its discretion, request verification for accomplishments relative to the above criteria.
- Awards will be made solely at the discretion of the Peer Review Panel.
- Other criteria may be considered at the option of the Panel and based on its collective best judgment in keeping with the spirit of the Green Fleet Leadership Awards.
